OWHA Rules and Regulations

a

Pick-Ups are not permitted for suspended players.

All Pickup Player requests must be completed via RAMP Games Portal using the 'PLAYERS AP REQUEST' link

b

For Regular Season League games, a team may pick up any eligible player, to a maximum of three (3) pick up players, from a lower category to bring the total team strength to, but not exceed, the number of officially registered players on the team. The OWHA may authorize the movement of a goaltender for emergency situations only, identified as being situations in which the team would have no roster goalie available to play.

Pick Up players are not eligible for Championship Weekend. (Exception for Goalies with League approval) NOTE: Pick up players are **NOT** permitted for OWHA provincial playdowns or championships

d

A Pick-Up Player is defined as EITHER from:
- a lower age level and the same classification or lower.
- the same age level and lower classification

e

(E.g.): 1 – U15 A team can call from U13 A team.
(E.g.): 2 – U15 A team can call from U13 BB team.
(E.g.): 3 - U15 A team can call from U15 BB team.
(E.g.): 4 – U15 A team can NOT call from U13 AA team

Any team found to have violated the Pick-Up Players rule by virtue of not having complied with any of the requirements or limits specified in Rule 7, subsections a) through e) will forfeit the game in which the violation(s) was found to have occurred and by a score that is in accordance with subsection 9) of the Forfeiture Policy listed in the OWHA Handbook. Teams violating Rule 7, as above, will be considered by the League to have used an ineligible or illegal player and the violation will be reported to the OWHA as a suspendable offence.

Pick up players must meet OWHA requirements including but not limited to prior written approval from the pickup players team/association.



Pickup/AP Players

London Devilettes Guidelines

The Pickup Player (also known as Affiliated Player/AP) program is governed by OWHL Rules and Regulations Section 6 – Pick-up Players : dated August 23, 2023

Pickup Players help teams to fill in for injured or absent players.

There is no additional fee collected from pickup players.

The London Devilettes Board of Directors encourages coaches to have position players and goalies from the team below you (your call up team) to skate with your team throughout the year. This makes for a seamless callup should your team experience an injury or illness as you will have a player that is familiar to your team

Pickup players cannot miss their own game or practice to be called up.

Pickup players must come from a team below the team requesting. For example, U11AA can call up from U11A, U11BB, U11B and U11HL, or U9B. The call up goes one way. A player at a higher category cannot go down, only up. In this example a U11A player can be called up to U11AA, U13AA and U13A and not down to U11BB, U111B or U11HL.

AP players must be from a London Devilettes team and not another OWHA association (ie. BAD Girls, St Thomas, Bluewater, etc). In turn, you cannot approve any of your London Devilettes players going to AP for a another OWHA organization team
